Pyramids tour

Your guide will meet you at the lobby of your hotel and accompany you as you are transferred to the Giza Plateau in an air-conditioned vehicle. Once you arrive, you will start your adventure by visiting the Pyramid of Cheops (The Great Pyramid of Giza), and then continue to the Pyramids of Chephren and Mykerinos, learning more about their architectural significance and fascinating history along the way. Finally, you will have plenty of perfect photo opportunities in front of the majestic Great Sphinx of Giza, one of the oldest, largest, and most photographed structures in the world.

Discover Alexandria's treasures

Alexandria, Egypt's captivating coastal jewel, is a city where Greek, Roman, and Egyptian influences intertwine, creating a rich tapestry of history and culture. Founded in 331 BC by Alexander the Great, it flourished as a center of knowledge and civilization, home to the fabled Great Library and the Pharos Lighthouse, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Begin your exploration at Pompey's Pillar, a striking 30-meter-high granite column erected in honor of Emperor Diocletian. Nearby, delve into the Kom El Shoqafa Catacombs, an underground burial site from the 1st and 2nd centuries AD, where Pharaonic, Greek, and Roman artistry blend in mesmerizing reliefs and sculptures. Next, visit the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern homage to its legendary predecessor. This architectural masterpiece is more than a library—it houses museums, cultural institutions, and research centers, ensuring Alexandria remains a beacon of knowledge. Stop by the Qaitabay Fortress, built on the ruins of the ancient Pharos Lighthouse. Overlooking the Mediterranean, this 15th-century stronghold offers stunning coastal views. End your journey in Montazah Gardens, a serene royal retreat with lush greenery, grand palaces, and breathtaking seaside scenery, where Egyptian monarchs once sought tranquility.

Timeless wonders of Egypt

Journey through time and uncover Egypt's most legendary treasures—the Pyramids of Giza, the Great Sphinx, and the Grand Egyptian Museum. Start at the Giza Plateau, home to the last remaining wonder of the ancient world. Walk around the Great Pyramid of Cheops, a masterpiece of engineering that has stood for over 4,500 years. Continue to the Pyramid of Chephren, still adorned with traces of its original limestone casing, and the Pyramid of Menkaure, the smallest yet equally captivating. Stop at a panoramic viewpoint to capture stunning photographs of all three pyramids before heading to the Great Sphinx. With its human face and lion's body, this mythical guardian of Giza has mesmerized visitors for centuries. Explore the Valley Temple, where ancient Egyptians carried out mummification rituals for their great rulers. Next, visit the Egyptian Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. Housing over 250,000 artifacts, the museum offers a rare glimpse into Egypt's rich history. Admire statues, mummies, and sacred relics, including the treasures of Tutankhamun, which remained untouched for 3,500 years until their discovery in 1922. (Please note: King Tut's mask will be relocated to the Grand Egyptian Museum before its opening.) A brief stop at a papyrus institute provides insight into the ancient art of papermaking, while an optional visit to a perfume or carpet workshop offers a chance to take home a piece of Egyptian craftsmanship.

A Seamless journey to the majestic temples of Abu Simbel

Mysteries of Luxor's West Bank

Venture into the mystical West Bank of Luxor, home to some of Egypt's most spectacular tombs and temples. Your journey begins in the Valley of the Kings, a desert necropolis where pharaohs prepared for eternity. Among the great rulers buried here are Ramses the Great, Tuthmosis III, and the legendary Tutankhamun. This temple, dedicated to Egypt's most powerful female pharaoh, is a testament to her remarkable reign and devotion to the gods. Conclude the tour with a photo stop at the Colossi of Memnon, the two towering statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which have guarded the West Bank for over 3,400 years. This half-day adventure offers a profound glimpse into Egypt's royal legacy, revealing the grandeur and mystery of pharaohs long past."
