
Pyramids tour

Visit the only remaining of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World and immerse yourself in the history of the Great Pyramids of Giza and feel the mystery of the Sphinx. Explore the site with your private guide and you may also opt to spice up your day with an added camel ride or head inside the Great Pyramid for a tour. Your guide will meet you at the lobby of your hotel and accompany you as you are transferred to the Giza Plateau in an air-conditioned vehicle. Once you arrive, you will start your adventure by visiting the Pyramid of Cheops (The Great Pyramid of Giza), and then continue to the Pyramids of Chephren and Mykerinos, learning more about their architectural significance and fascinating history along the way. Finally, you will have plenty of perfect photo opportunities in front of the majestic Great Sphinx of Giza, one of the oldest, largest, and most photographed structures in the world.


Timeless wonders of Egypt

Journey through time and uncover Egypt's most legendary treasures—the Pyramids of Giza, the Great Sphinx, and the Grand Egyptian Museum. This tour blends the mystique of the pharaohs, the grandeur of ancient architecture, and the splendor of some of the world's most remarkable artifacts. Start at the Giza Plateau, home to the last remaining wonder of the ancient world. Walk around the Great Pyramid of Cheops, a masterpiece of engineering that has stood for over 4,500 years. Continue to the Pyramid of Chephren, still adorned with traces of its original limestone casing, and the Pyramid of Menkaure, the smallest yet equally captivating. Stop at a panoramic viewpoint to capture stunning photographs of all three pyramids before heading to the Great Sphinx. With its human face and lion's body, this mythical guardian of Giza has mesmerized visitors for centuries. Explore the Valley Temple, where ancient Egyptians carried out mummification rituals for their great rulers. Next, visit the Egyptian Museum, home to the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. Housing over 250,000 artifacts, the museum offers a rare glimpse into Egypt's rich history. Admire statues, mummies, and sacred relics, including the treasures of Tutankhamun, which remained untouched for 3,500 years until their discovery in 1922. (Please note: King Tut's mask will be relocated to the Grand Egyptian Museum before its opening.) A brief stop at a papyrus institute provides insight into the ancient art of papermaking, while an optional visit to a perfume or carpet workshop offers a chance to take home a piece of Egyptian craftsmanship.


