

Athens city and Cape Sounion tour

Explore Plaka's charming streets before a scenic drive along the Athens Riviera, passing Glyfada, Vouliagmeni, Voula, and Varkiza beaches. Reach Cape Sounion to witness the captivating Temple of Poseidon, where majestic sunset views against a dramatic mountain backdrop await.

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National Archeological Museum

Afterward, enjoy a scenic vehicle tour of Athens, passing key landmarks like the Panathenaic Stadium, Zappeion, and the Monument of the Unknown Soldier, where you can witness the iconic changing of the guards.

Feel like a native, swim at the beautiful and not so crowded Fokos beach and work up an appetite for picnic filled with local delicacies of Mykonos served right on the beach, which are directly linked to its history and tradition. And don't forget one of the highlights of this tour: the local wine, produced by a Mykonian organic farm!

Panoramic Rhodes and old city tour

Today you will have the opportunity to discover the highlights of ancient and modern-day Rhodes during this picturesque orientation tour of the city. Depart with a scenic drive through the modern areas of Rhodes. As you pass by the Mandraki Esplanade, you will see the government buildings, the Church of Annunciation built in 1925, a replica of the Old Church of the Knights of St John, and the deer statues at the entrance of Mandraki port, your driver will then continue up to Monte Smith for panoramic views and photo opportunities of Rhodes and the Aegean Sea and the view from the distance the Acropolis of Rhodes with its Ancient stadium nearby built 2nd Century BC. You will then continue on to Rhodes Medieval City. Once you reach the Gate d'Amboise, you will disembark and proceed to the Grand Master's Palace for a guided walking tour. The Palace was built in the 14th century A.D., destroyed in 1856, and rebuilt in 1939 by the Italians in order to accommodate the King of Italy, Emmanuel II, and Mussolini. You will then walk down the Street of the Knights, where you will see the many inns once occupied by the crusaders. At the end of the street, you will arrive at the Archaeological Museum, formerly the Knights Hospital, the museum was built in 1440 A.D., and is the most well-preserved building in the Old City.

Cretan villages and countryside tour

Stop at the impressive Koules Fortress with views over Souda Gulf before visiting the quaint Maheri village for a leisurely stroll and refreshments at a traditional kafenion. Continue inland to the studio of a renowned local ceramicist, showcasing traditional architecture. Conclude your journey along the foothills of the White Mountains, savoring a rustic meal at a family-run tavern with panoramic valley and sea views.

Tour to a traditional farm of Crete
