Tour of the Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica

Explore some of the world's most renowned landmarks accompanied by your knowledgeable guide who will share the history, lesser-known details and intriguing stories of these magical sites. Your exploration starts with the grandiose Vatican Museum with masterpieces from the masters of the Renaissance period including the famous Sistine Chapel by Michelangelo. After a brief walk through the streets of Vatican, you will then reach St Peter's Basilica, one of the most important Christian monuments in the World, where you will among other sights be able to explore the Pietà by Michelangelo in great detail.

Rome and Colosseum tour

Set off on a private tour that will let you explore the most prominent sites and landmarks of Ancient Rome, stopping first at the mighty Colosseum where your experienced guide will provide a memorable narrated tour and an interesting account of its history. The Colosseum, constructed of concrete and sand, and completed in 80 AD, remains the largest amphitheater ever built. It was once used for gladiator contests, mock sea battles, public spectacles, and executions. Let your guide bring to life the immense effort needed to build the amphitheater, the gladiators' fights and the political skirmishes that created turmoil in ancient Romans' everyday life. While driving around piazza Venezia, admire the imposing buildings around, and especially the Vittoriano; then, enjoy the impressive scenery created by the Spanish Steps and the splendor of the Trevi Fountain (here, you will want to keep a coin at hand, to throw it in the fountain and ensure your coming back!). Reach Piazza Navona and hit the Pantheon square, where artists and performers find their ideal stage. As you continue your tour you will see the most impressive square of Rome, the cradle of Christianity, and admire St Peter's Basilica façade and the sumptuous colonnade that Bernini envisaged as the embracing arms of the Catholic Church.

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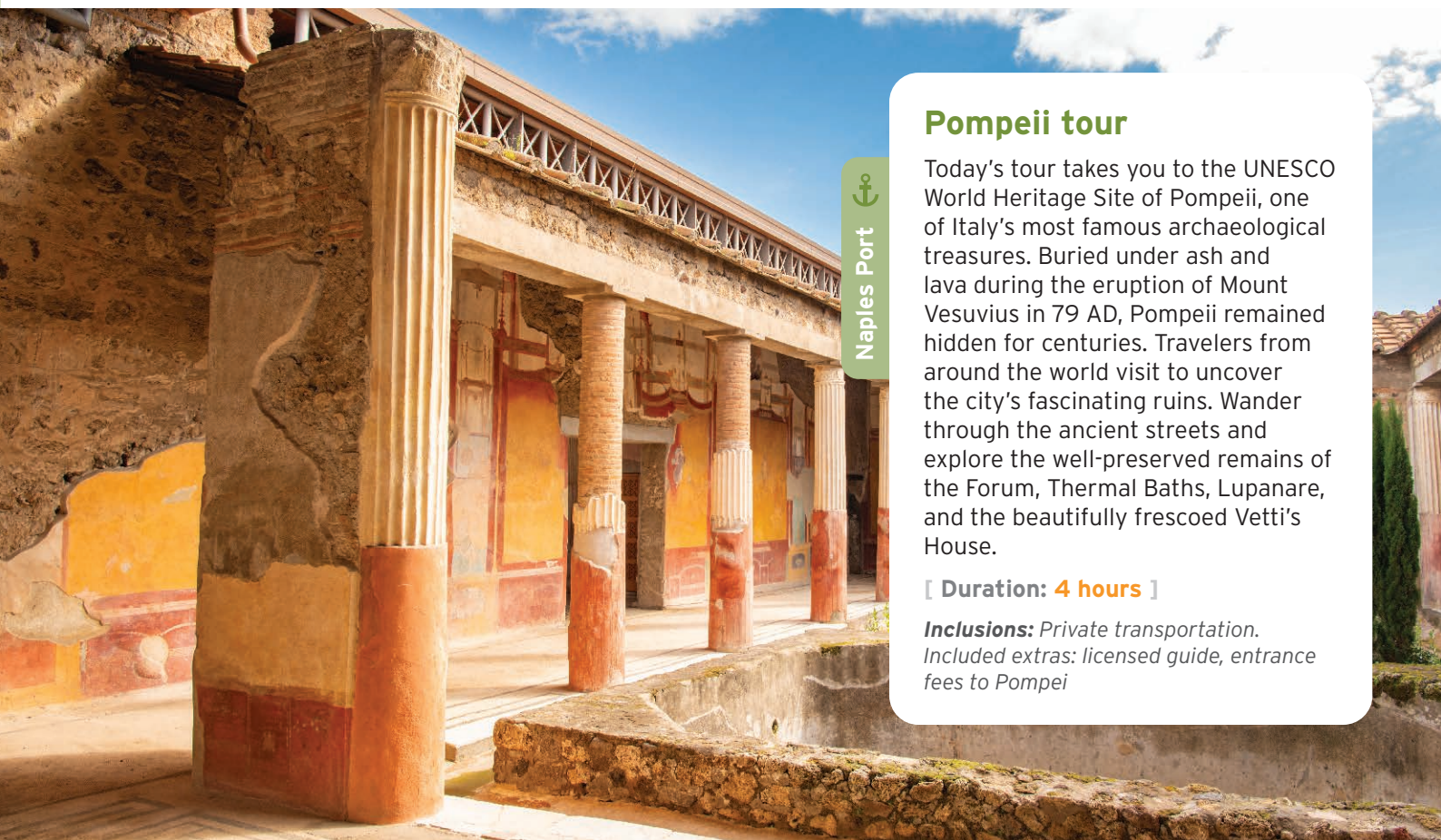
Pompeii tour

Today's tour takes you to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Pompeii, one of Italy's most famous archaeological treasures. Buried under ash and lava during the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD, Pompeii remained hidden for centuries. Travelers from around the world visit to uncover the city's fascinating ruins. Wander through the ancient streets and explore the well-preserved remains of the Forum, Thermal Baths, Lupanare, and the beautifully frescoed Vetti's House.

Naples underground tour

Start with the fascinating Naples Underground Tour, where you'll explore the city's hidden history. This 1.5-hour tour takes you deep beneath the streets, offering a unique perspective on the layers of history that shaped Naples. (Please note that the visit involves some walking and descending into the underground.) Afterward, take a leisurely stroll down Via Tribunali, a vibrant street in Naples' historic center, lined with iconic pizzerias, cafes, and historic buildings that capture the essence of local life. Next, visit the charming San Gregorio Armeno, a narrow street renowned for its workshops crafting beautiful Nativity scenes. Then, head to the magnificent Duomo di San Gennaro, the cathedral dedicated to Naples' patron saint, San Gennaro. Enjoy a quick Neapolitan pizza at a local pizzeria (cost not included), a must-try when in Naples! In the afternoon, explore the Roman Theatre and the remains of the ancient aqueduct, before concluding your tour at Piazza del Plebiscito, Naples' grand central square. Afterward, you'll return to your ship, man Theatre and the remains of the aqueduct and end your tour in Piazza del Plebiscito, Naples' grand central square, before return to your ship.

Walking tour of Florence with Academy Museum

Florence is the cradle of the Italian Renaissance. This graceful and elegant city is worth every minute you spend exploring it. Accompanied by your experienced guide you will have the opportunity to enjoy a relaxing walk around the city and see some of its most important sites, such as Giotto's bell tower, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria, but also have a glimpse at some of the lesser known but equally noteworthy sites, like the Orsanmichele façade or the "porcellino" (piglet) fountain and discover one of the few examples of florentine Baroque architecture, in piazza San Firenze. You will then visit the famous Academy, home to some of Michelangelo's most famous statues, such as the unfinished but extraordinarily expressive Prigioni, and the David, depicted right before his battle with Goliath.

Tour to Pisa and Lucca

Discover Pisa, the city that boasts the finest examples of Romanesque style. Accompanied by your English-speaking guide, you will explore Piazza Dei Miracoli, where you will find all monumental pieces of art: the Cathedral, where Galileo Galilei was inspired to invent the pendulum clock, the Baptistery, the Monumental Cemetery, and the famous Leaning Tower. Then, you will head to Lucca, another gem of Italian architecture with a discreet but undeniable charm. Surrounded by an almost intact City wall, Lucca is a "man-size" town with a pedestrian island that allows visitors to wander around and enjoy the shops in peace. During the tour, you will enjoy a light but luscious Tuscan meal with wine at a local restaurant in Lucca.

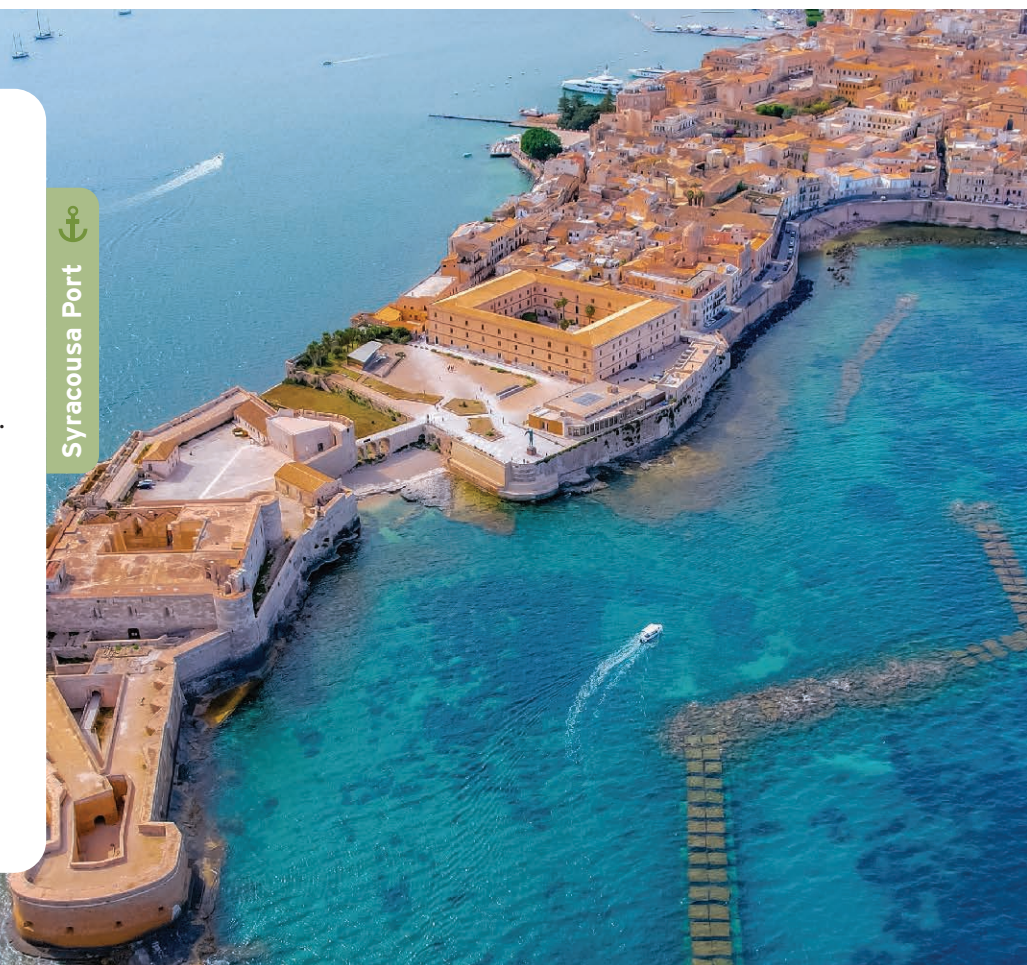
Siracuse tour

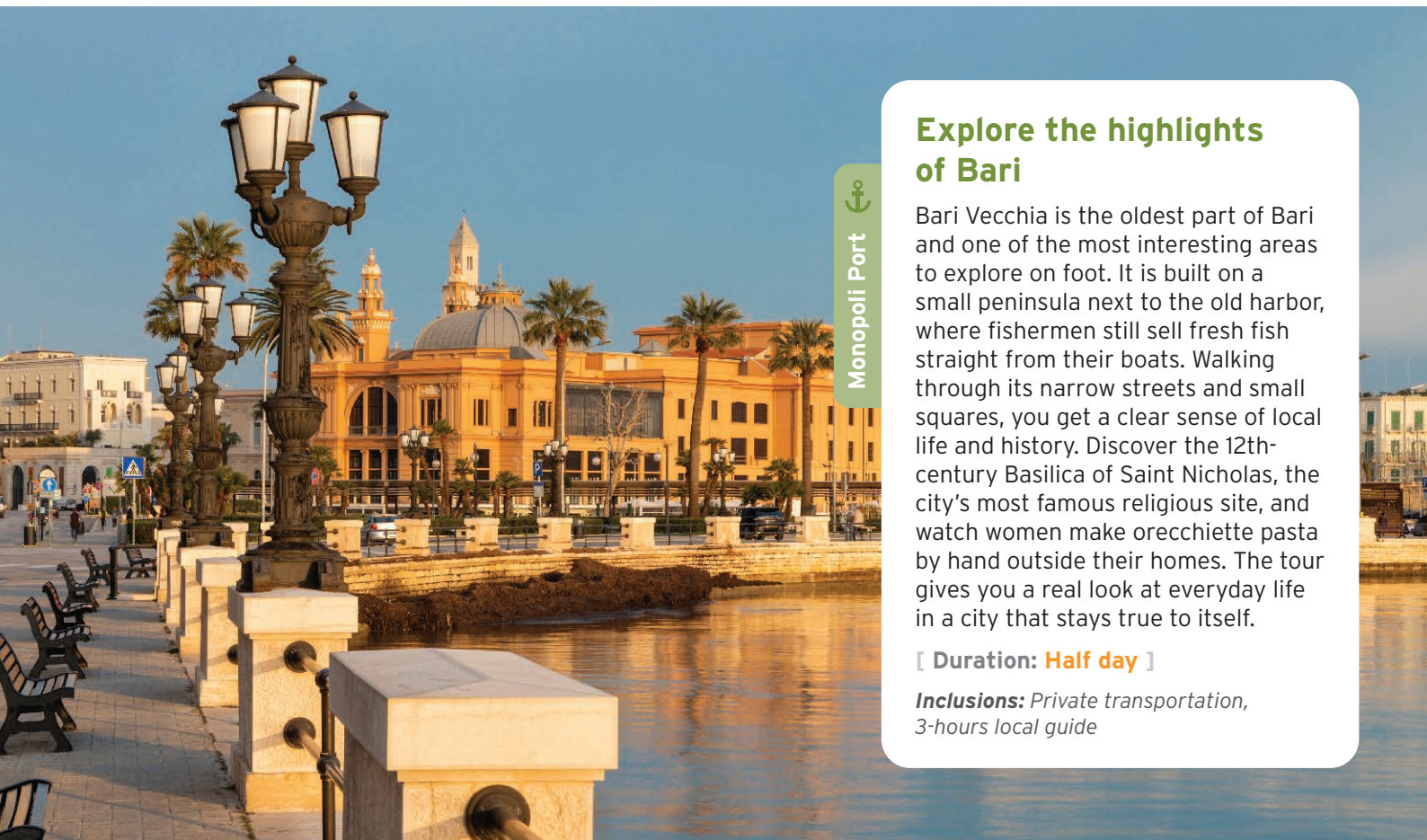
Explore the highlights of Bari

Bari Vecchia is the oldest part of Bari and one of the most interesting areas to explore on foot. It is built on a small peninsula next to the old harbor, where fishermen still sell fresh fish straight from their boats. Walking through its narrow streets and small squares, you get a clear sense of local life and history. Discover the 12th-century Basilica of Saint Nicholas, the city's most famous religious site, and watch women make orecchiette pasta by hand outside their homes. The tour gives you a real look at everyday life in a city that stays true to itself.
