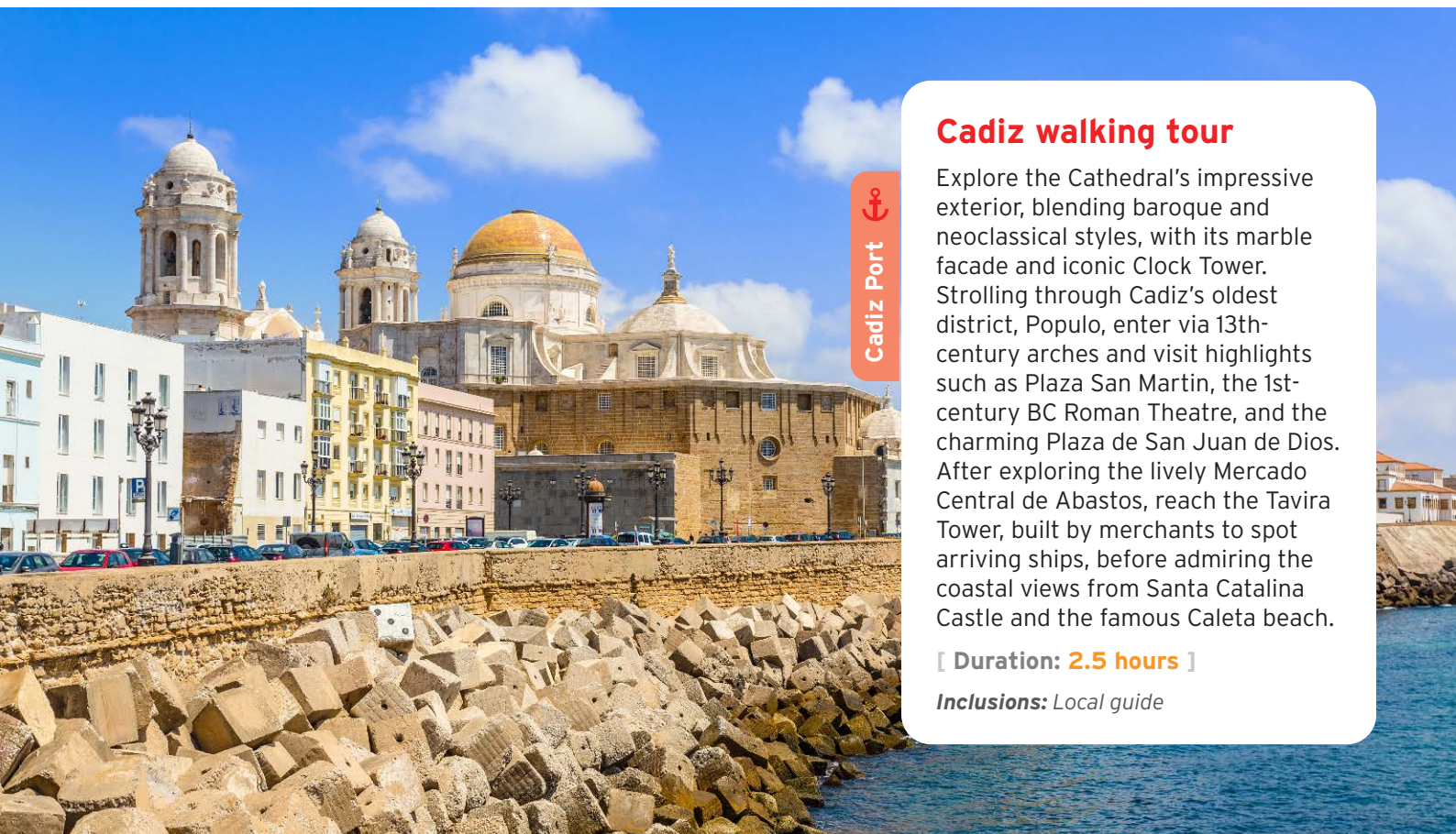
Cadiz walking tour
