DAY 1 / Zurich

DAY 2 / Walking tour of Zurich

DAY 5 / Zurich to Florence

DAY 6 / Florence gondola ride

Florence is the cradle of the Italian Renaissance. This graceful and elegant city is worth every minute you spend exploring it. Accompanied by your experienced guide you will have the opportunity to enjoy a relaxing walk around the city and see some of its most important sites, such as Giotto's bell tower, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria, but also have a glimpse at some of the lesser known but equally noteworthy sites, like the Orsanmichele façade or the "porcellino" (piglet) fountain.

DAY 7 / San Gimignano and Siena tour with wine tasting

Today you will drive through the marvelous Tuscan countryside to San Gimignano, known as the Manhattan of Tuscany because of its skyline filled with towers. Take in all the wonderful scenery while walking through the cobbled streets and continue on to one of the nearby farms, with a beautiful view of San Gimignano. Along with stunning views, you will also have the opportunity to visit their vineyards and wineries, savor a range of delicious Tuscan dishes during lunch and taste delectable wines. Your next stop will be Siena, where your guide will join you and show you the splendor of this stunning medieval town and introduce you to the famous horse race, II Palio, that takes place only twice a year.







DAY 8 / Tour to Pisa

After a pleasant drive, you will reach Pisa, the birthplace of Galilei. Once there you will explore the beautiful and historic city, with the help of your experienced guide. During your thorough walking tour, you'll explore Piazza dei Miracoli and its fascinating monuments. You will be dazzled by the Field of Miracles, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that houses numerous world-famous monuments including the Leaning Tower, the cathedral - a shining example of the distinctive Pisa Romanesque architecture, the "Campo Santo" cemetery, the Baptistery, and the cathedral museum. This visit focused on Piazza dei Miracoli will unveil not only the magnificence of the various monuments but also the history and the stories behind all of them.

DAY 9 / Florence to Rome

After breakfast and hotel check-out, your driver will meet you for the private transfer to Rome and your selected hotel in the Eternal City.

/ Rome tour by golf cart

Among the sites you see on this tour is the Colosseum (outside), Trevi fountain, Spanish Steps, Pantheon and Piazza Navona.

DAY 10 / Tour of Rome with Colosseum and Vatican Museums

Discover Rome in a day with a private tour that blends history, culture, and breathtaking sights. Explore the Colosseum, a symbol of imperial power, and stroll through the Roman Forum, once the heart of political life. Toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain before admiring Piazza Navona and the Pantheon. At the Vatican Museums, marvel at masterpieces by Raphael and Botticelli before reaching the Sistine Chapel, where Michelangelo's frescoes bring history to life. DAY 11 / Day tour to Pompeii
